PBM Clever's Son is by one of the 50 top sires in Germany, PBM Cleverboy, who jumped in international S\*\* competition with Markus Beerbaum as well as competing successfully in dressage with Olympic medalist Martin Schaudt. At his stallion licensing test, Cleverboy received scores of 127 for dressage (putting him into the top best dressage horses in Germany) and 114 for jumping.

Clever's Son's bloodline speaks for itself with grand sire such as Come On. Come On was Reserve Champion of his Performance Test (Grading) in Medingen, Germany with over 141 points. His versatility, superb temperament and rideability is evident from the way he went on to compete at the highest level in international show jumping for numerous years with different riders including HRH Princess Haya of Jordan, Ludger Beerbaum and Ralf Schneider. His successes include second in the Goteborg Grand Prix, third in the Hickstead Grand Prix and fourth



in the Hamburg Derby. Come On has been ranked as number one in the German National Federation's breeding rankings as a result of his numerous state premium daughters and stallion approved sons. Notable horses by Come On include PBM Cleverboy, Come Well, Classico W, Comitee,



Cadeau, Cinderella, JR, Comet and Move On.

Clever's Son's dam Lagune is by Labrador, who is by one of the most famous foundation stallions of all time, Ladykiller, not to mention stallions like Der Loewe and Lugano I who is the grand sire to the world famous Darco.

Clever's Son himself was awarded premiership in Germany as a youngster and this shows in his fantastic temperament, confirmation and his ability to perform. He has competed in higher level show jumping and dressage competitions in continental Europe.
